From: The 2010 Grading Committee
RE: Final Computations of NJROTC Grades

A cadre of Lemon Bay NJROTC Cadets, consisting of NS1's through NS4's, was tasked with figuring out the best system for computing cadets grades. NJROTC cadets are required and expected to do much more than the typical high school student, for instance, wearing a uniform and participating in physical activities. The Committee met to discuss and determine the basic guidelines of the cadets grading system. They were to decide whether to keep or modify the current structure. After The Committee met, they came to concluding decisions. The New grading criteria is as follows:

Test

Homework

Participation in Physical Fitness

Uniforms

Uniform Inspections

Classroom Decorum, Attitude, Participation, and Drill

Event Participation (Cannot be banked. Field Trips do NOT count as part of Participation grade)

All of the above will have EQUAL value in determining the final grade for all NJROTC Cadets, with the exception of Event Participation that will count as 10% of overall grade.

In addition to the Rules and Regulations that you have already signed and agreed to, the following will apply:

Homework that is late may be turned in the next day for half credit, and continue to decrease in percentage with every day. Homework must be turned in within one week of the assigned date.

Tests may be made up anytime during the grading period with no penalty; however, it is the cadet's responsibility to inform the NJROTC Instructors when the test will be made up. The Instructor will advise the cadets 2 times during the grading period that a test is

missing. If no effort is made by the cadet, then a ZERO will be assigned to that test.

If a cadet does not wear his/her uniform on the assigned day, they may wear it the next day for half credit. If the uniform is not worn, the cadet will be given a ZERO. If the cadet misses wearing his/her uniform three or more times during any quarter, it will result in a FAILING grade for that quarter. To obtain credit for wearing the uniform, it must be properly worn for the entire school day.

If a cadet does not wear his/her uniform on the designated Uniform Inspection Day, they may wear it the next day in school for a penalty of 20 POINTS deducted from his/her inspection grade. If the uniform is not worn, a ZERO will be assigned for that Uniform Inspection.

Note: If a cadet has an excused absence on any day that a test, homework, or uniform is required, no penalty will be enforced providing all other criteria is met. All other make-up criteria will be IAW the Charlotte County Attendance Policy.

It is imperative that all Lemon Bay NJROTC Cadets remain cognizant of the status regarding their grades. All cadets will be able to view current grades using <https://focus.yourcharlotteschools.net/focus/>
